Non-exclusionary use in the Pacific (to include PBCS)

A153 ADS-B International (As of November 2018 no longer required or issued)

Flight Plan Code 10b: LB1, and item 18: SUR/ 260B when equipped

B034 **P-RNAV** non-ICAO PBN SIDs/STARs (As of February 2020 no longer required or issued)

Flight Plan Codes none

Not accepted by most States outside the EU

B036 Multiple Long Range Navigation Systems, Oceanic and Remote domestic

Flight Plan Codes item 18: PBN A1(RNP 10), L1(RNP4), and NAV/RNP 2

RNP 10 (ICAO RNAV 10) required for oceanic and remote operations

RNP 4 required on specific routes in Hong Kong and designated tracks North Atlantic

RNP 2 required in Australia (Nov 2020)

B039 North Atlantic High Level Airspace (NAT HLA)

Flight Plan Code 10a:X

Required for operations within the North Atlantic region FL285 to FL420

The North Atlantic also requires a PBN authorization for RNAV 10, and/or RNP 4

B046 **RVSM** International

Flight Plan Code 10a: W

Currently required by ICAO for international operations

Not required for U.S. domestic operations if ADS-B equipped

C048 Enhanced Flight Vision Systems (EFVS) Operations

Flight Plan Code none

No requirements for use, authorization required for credit for reduced minimums

C052 LPV Approach International

Flight Plan Code 10a: B

Required for use of LPV minimums on a State-by-State basis, as identified in the AIP

C063 RNAV and RNP Terminal Operations (SIDs and STARs)

Flight Plan Codes item 18: PBN/D plus equipage RNAV1 and O plus equipage RNP1

RNAV 1 required in China and Brazil and expanding rapidly (P-RNAV approvals not accepted)

RNP 1 required in Hong Kong

RNP 1 required in Australia (Nov 2020)

D195 **MEL** International

Flight Plan Codes none

Required worldwide (previously enforced in the EU)

D095 MMEL must include all 4 elements to be valid
