Subject: ACAS Version 7.1 requirements in EU airspace

Dear Mr Carr,

We would like to draw your attention to the upcoming entry into force of the last milestone of the EU Commission Regulation No 1332/2011 concerning the ACAS version 7.1 requirements for flights in the EU Airspace.

As of <u>01 December 2015</u>, all aeroplanes with a MCTOM in excess of 5700 kgs or authorised to carry more than 19 passengers need to be equipped with ACAS II v. 7.1 in order to operate into EU airspace<sup>1</sup>.

Could we please ask you to relay once more this information to all your members in order to ensure a swift transition and avoid disruption in their respective operations to, from and into the EU Airspace?
